#### Laudato Si' Week

Pope Francis invites Catholic communities around the world to participate in Laudato Si' 2022 Week which is this coming week 22<sup>nd</sup> – 29<sup>th</sup> May 2022. The week long global event will mark the seventh anniversary of Pope Francis' landmark encyclical on creation care and unite the world's 1.3 billion Catholics to listen and respond to the cry of God's creation. We will celebrate Laudato Si' week within our Diocese by holding a Mass at St. Mary's Cathedral at 7pm on Monday May 23<sup>rd</sup>. Bishop Robert will preside at the Mass and Fr Chris Hughes will give the homily on "hearing the cry of the poor and the earth". Music will be provided by pupils from Sacred Heart High School, Fenham. Everyone is welcome to attend this special Mass focusing on creation care.
