Parish Mission Statement

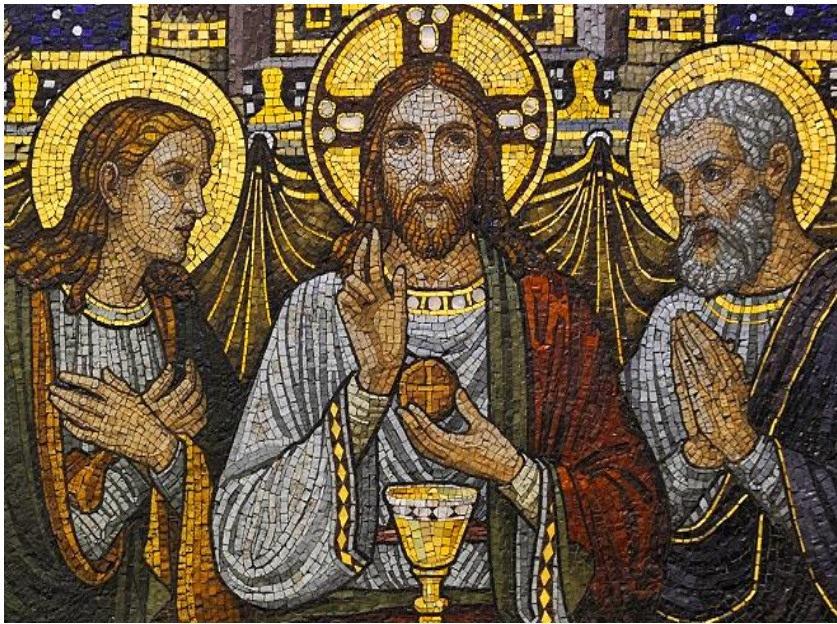
