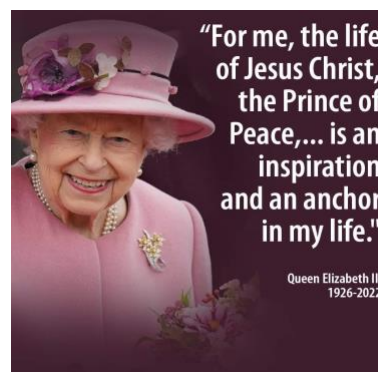

### Queen Elizabeth II



It is with deep sadness we learnt of the death of our Queen, Elizabeth II on Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> September. We pray for the repose of her soul and for her family as they mourn the loss of a mother, grandmother and great grandmother.

May she rest in the peace and presence of Jesus Christ.

A statement by Cardinal Nichols has been published on the death of Her Majesty and is placed at the back of church along with prayers for the Queen and our new King. Mass for the repose of the soul of the Queen may be celebrated this weekend (see Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> September) and Bishop Robert will be celebrating our Diocesan Requiem Mass in the Cathedral nearer the date of the Queen's funeral. Further details will follow. **May her soul rest in peace.**
