

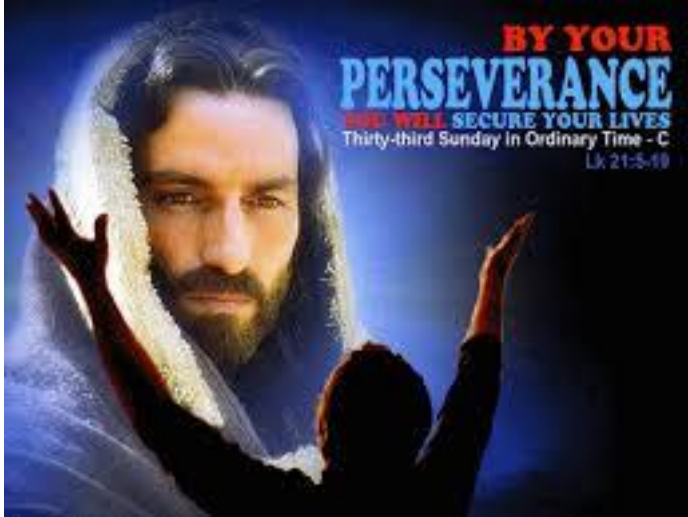

Parish Pastoral Council Elections

Prayer Vigils at Derwentside Immigration Removal Centre Corbridge Road, Medomsley DH8 6QY

A short prayer vigil has been held on the first Sunday of each month at 3 pm outside the barrier to the Immigration Centre since August 2021 co-ordinated by the Justice and Peace Co-ordinating Council. We believe detaining women who are asking for a safe place to live goes against our faith; we are asked to welcome the stranger and feed the hungry. This is an opportunity to give witness and pray for the women detained there. You are very welcome to join us there or to pray with us from home. Future dates planned are December 4th, February 5th, March 5th (there will not be an in-person vigil in January).
