This weekend is the First Sunday of Advent, Cycle A. We, as a parish community, wish to begin this Holy Season of Advent with an Advent Wreath Celebration, prior to this Sunday's Vigil Mass. Advent is a time of expectation and hope filled with rich traditions. "Advent" means "arrival" or "coming," and it prompts us to pause each day in December and remember why Jesus came at Christmas. The Advent Wreath and candles provide beautiful symbolism for each week of Advent as we wait for Christmas to arrive. A new candle is lit on each of the four Sundays before Christmas. Each candle represents something different, although traditions vary.

### **Advent Alms**

Part of our preparation could be almsgiving via the left-hand Wall Box as you leave church. All donations received will go to St. Cuthbert's Care who are committed to helping improve lives of some of the most vulnerable of our society.
