Our Advent Preparations

This weekend is the third Sunday of Advent, Cycle A. Advent is a time of expectation and hope filled with rich traditions. "Advent" means "arrival" or "coming," and it prompts us to pause each day in December and remember why Jesus came at Christmas. We, as a parish community, began this Holy Season of Advent with an Advent Wreath Celebration. The Advent Wreath and candles provide beautiful symbolism for each week of Advent as we wait for Christmas to arrive. A new candle is lit on each of the four Sundays before Christmas. Each candle represents something different, although traditions vary.
