Our Advent Preparations

This weekend is the fourth, and last, Sunday of Advent, Cycle A. Advent is a time of preparation, (see note opposite 're Reconciliation Service) expectation and hope filled with rich traditions. "Advent" means "arrival" or "coming," and it prompts us to pause each day in December and remember why Jesus came at Christmas.
