
Parish Mission Statement

Lent

Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, 22nd February 2023, and ends at sundown on Holy Thursday. Ash Wednesday dates from at least the fourth century, and that penitents durina century, looking forgiveness and re-entry into the community would dress in sackcloth and sprinkle ashes to show their repentance. The distributing of ashes on Ash Wednesday imitates the practice of wearing ashes by public penitents. The Church asks Catholics 14 years of age or older and between the ages of 16 and 59 to fast and abstain from meat on certain days, limiting food to one full meal a day with the possibility of two smaller meals as needed, not to eat meat, although fish is allowed. Pregnant and nursing women are exempt from the fast. Throughout our history, Christians have found prayer, fasting, and almsgiving to be an important part of repentance and renewal. Many now add something during Lent rather than giving up something to add some outreach to others in need. To do nothing would certainly not be in keeping with the spirit of Lent. Furthermore, the sacrifices and extra things we do for Lent help us grow closer to Christ. We are missing out on so many graces if we do not participate fully in Lent. It is not necessary to be perfect, but we should put forth a good effort.
