


Parish Mission Statement

Many now add something during Lent rather than giving up something to add some outreach to others in need. To do nothing would certainly not be in keeping with the spirit of Lent. Furthermore, the sacrifices and extra things we do for Lent help us grow closer to Christ. We are missing out on so many graces if we do not participate fully in Lent.
