The food bank is very short of donations and is currently having to spend about £300 per week, just to keep pace with demand. Perhaps we could have a focused drive one weekend per month across both parishes which would help to boost stocks. Some ideas:

- 1. Tinned Fruit, Custard, Rice Pudding, Angel Delight, Jellies
- 2. Pasta Rice Noodles (and for single people 2 minute varieties of pasta and Pot Noodles)
- 3. Pasta and Curry Sauce Jars, Passata, etc
- 4. Tinned Meat or Fish. Tins of Ready Made Curry, Chilli, and Meatballs etc
- 5 Tinned Peas, Sweetcorn, Carrots, Mixed Vegetables, Potatoes etc
- 6 Tea, Coffee, Sugar, Juices.
- 7. Treats, both sweet and savoury. Crisps, Biscuits, Sweets
- 8 Toilet Rolls, Washing Up Liquid, Washing Liquid or Pods (these are handy to split up)
- 9. Shower or Bath Gel, Shampoo, Conditioner, Soap, Toothpaste, Deodorant and Handwash
- 10. Tinned Soups, Beans, Spaghetti etc
- 11 Red and Brown Sauce, Mayonnaise and Dried Packet of mixes for Chicken . Pork etc.
