#### Car Park

There have been concerns for some time about the appalling state of the Car Park which is the property of Shenstone. It doesn't not belong to St. Paul's Parish. We approached the local Councillor with these issues and the Council then wrote to Shenstone. The reply was that Shenstone were not planning to do any repairs. Since that contact we met with a Shenstone rep, have raised the issue with the local MP but it seems again this has had no effect. Ultimately, we have no leverage to progress this further. However, if individuals do wish to complain directly to the owner or via their Councillors/MP it may hold more weight if enough people do complain about this matter. The shops nearby may also have an issue and may be willing to complain and request repair.
