

Celebration of Masses in St. John's and St. Paul's

Fr. Manoj will return home on Monday 16th and will celebrate Mass on Tuesday 17th at 10.00am in St John's, 10.00am on Wednesday 18th and Thursday 19th in St. Paul's as usual. He will then travel to Fatima on Pilgrimage with next weekend's Masses (21st/22nd) celebrated by visiting priests. There will be no weekday Masses between 23rd-27th September and he will resume celebrating Mass as usual from 28th September in both parishes.

He will return home to India for his annual holiday from 15th October – 15th November and during that time there will be NO WEEKDAY MASSES celebrated in either St. John's or St. Paul's. Weekend Masses will be celebrated, at their usual times, in both parishes by Fr. Stanly.

Jubilee Year

The Holy Father has declared 2025 to be a Jubilee Year with the motto and theme "Pilgrims of Hope."

There will be two Holy Doors in our Diocese, one at St. Mary's Cathedral and one at St. Joseph's Church, Hartlepool. The Bishop is very grateful to Canon Paul Douthwaite for his welcome to pilgrims at St. Joseph's. The Holy Father has decreed that the Holy Doors are opened on Sunday 29th December. It is the Bishop's intention to celebrate both openings that day. The Holy Doors will be closed on 6th January 2026.
